It is a key reference for parents, children, adolescents and professionals on all issues related to the digital world, its uses and its potential dangers (cyberbullying, exposure to screens, pornography, video games, sex predators, parental control, identity theft, scams, fake news, etc).

Approved by the Ministry of National Education for more than 10 years, the association acts on a daily basis to carry out awareness-raising actions in schools from primary to high school. It trains parents, professionals, peers and partners on **the risks and responsible uses of the Internet.**

Educational Objectives & Subjects Discussed



Better understanding for better use is an educational intervention aimed at middle school students. Organized around debates and scenarios, it aims to **encourage children aged 11 to 14 years** to talk about their own experiences and uses of digital technology.

The pedagogical intervention “**Better understanding for better use**” provided by the e-Enfance Association is not limited to the theme of **cyberbullying**. Other subjects such as the practice of young people online and in particular health (connection time, sleep), personal data (**e-reputation**, right to be forgotten), disinformation (**fake news**), sexuality (pornography, romantic relationships, consent, revenge porn, sexual blackmail) can also be addressed.

In addition, the 3018, the number of the national line for the protection of minors on the Internet is presented.

Objectives



Parents often have this unpleasant impression of being overwhelmed by the digital life of their children (social networks, screen time, video games, etc.) and of not mastering the codes as well as they do. They may sometimes lack the resources and the ease to support them in this increasingly important digital environment. This often induces two opposite behaviors: too much **worry**, or a **trivialization of the dangers** that their children may face.

However, by training in the use of the Internet and having a general knowledge of the use that young people make of digital tools, they can become real **e-parents!**

- **For parents of teenagers**, the e-Enfance association focuses its educational intervention on parenting support for teenagers including. **(cyberbullying (compliance with the law on the internet, respecting oneself, respecting others), health risks (screen time, sleep), protection of personal data (e-reputation) sexuality (exposure to pornography, romantic relationships), the use of video games (addiction), misinformation (fake news and conspiracy theories), self-endangerment (challenges).**
