On Friday, October 9, 2026, our 6eme and MYP 1 students will be leaving the classroom for a day like no other: destination Grottes des Demoiselles!

A trip to observe, explore, and understand science... life-size!

Deep inside the cave, students will discover and understand phenomena they study in physics-chemistry, life and earth sciences, and general science:

How does water shape rock and create caves?

How do rocks form and evolve?

What phenomena related to water and changes of state can be observed?

How does an underground ecosystem work?

They will also take part in an educational geology workshop, learning through observation, hands-on activity, and inquiry.

Because at EPBI, we believe that science is meant to be experienced as much as learned!
